We are continuing to use this platform to provide home learning activities in English and maths. These are practical activities that the whole family could get involved with. They do not require expensive or hard to get resources. The platform can be accessed via your mobile phone. All we ask is that you take a photo and/or leave a comment to let us know how your child got on. Once a new topic has been released, you will get an email/text straight to your phone where you will be able to watch a short video clip to show you how the activity works.

Every Friday, as part of our Flying High assembly we recognize those children who have engaged with learning outside of the classroom and each Key Stage has a Milo Monkey 'trophy' which they can keep for the week. We celebrate children's learning in our newsletter. It is lovely for teachers, as well as the Senior Leadership Team to be able to work together with parents in building on learning within the classroom. We look forward to seeing those comments and photos flying in!

Reading Records – We're going digital!

From Monday the 11th September we will be using digital reading logs for all children. These are part of our Learning with Parents platform and are very easy to use.

Every Monday, you will receive an email OR text reminding you of your child's weekly reading target. You click on the link in that email or text, listen to your child read and then add a comment, photo or an audio clip of how it went.

If you have already signed up to our platform you should not need to do anything as you are already linked, but if you have never signed up or have had any problems with logging in, then please contact Miss Warner or Mrs Peart via the school office.

Passwords are no longer needed but you will need to check your emails/texts.

We are a charity working to help families enjoy learning together at home.

On your mobile phone, tablet or computer, you can log your child's reading by leaving comments, photos or audio clips. The class teacher then gets your feedback and photos so they can see how your child is getting on.

How does it work?

- 1) You will receive an email or text from us every week with a weekly reading target.
- 2) Click on the link in the email to be taken to your child's reading log – no need for passwords!
- 3) Leave comments, photos, and audio clips of your child reading for your class teacher.
