School Dinners

If you pay for your child's school dinners you will need to top up the account labelled "dinners". Each day we take a register online and the money will show as debited from your account.

Breakfast Club and Care Club

You will continue to book the club with the main office.

If your child is a regular attender at breakfast club or care club you will need to top up the accounts labelled "Breakfast Club" and "Care Club".

On a Monday afternoon we will debit your account for any sessions attended the previous week.

Shop

You can purchase items from the shop (under the tab "payments"). This currently includes uniform and enrichment clubs but other items will be added soon, such as residential trips.

Enrichment clubs – cost a voluntary contribution of £2.00, **please only order and "checkout" this item once a space at the club has been confirmed by the main office.**





This term your child will be learning the following:

English:

We will be reading the following books: Ruby's Worry, Where The Wild Things Are, Naughty Bus, The Hedgehog and When I am By Myself.

Maths:

We will be learning numbers within 10, addition and subtraction within 10, shape and patterns, numbers to 20 and addition and subtraction within 20.

Humanities:

Before half term we will be focusing on geography learning about our local area. After half term we will be studying history looking at toys in time.

Science:

We will be learning about different everyday materials and their properties. We will understand the difference between objects and materials.

Art and DT:

In art we will be learning drawing techniques, focusing on lines and spirals.
After half term we will be looking at cooking and nutrition in DT.

RE:

Pupils will be learning about Christianity and the Creation Story.

Music:

Pupils will continue to develop their understanding of pulse, pitch and rhythm by exploring a wide range of musical genres.

PSHE:

Pupils will learn about the differences between EYFS and Year 1. Pupils will also learn about different feelings and how we can show them. We will also talk about how different emotions can change people's behaviour.

Computing:

This term pupils will be learning about E-Safety and how to log in to the computer using their own log on details.

PE:

Pupils will be learning how to follow instructions and use the space safely. Children will be studying Health and Fitness and Hockey.
