School Dinners

If you pay for your child’s school dinners you will need to top up the account labelled “dinners”. Each day we take a register online and the money will show as debited from your account.

Breakfast Club and Care Club

You will continue to book the club with the main office.

If your child is a regular attender at breakfast club or care club you will need to top up the accounts labelled “Breakfast Club” and “Care Club”.

On a Monday afternoon we will debit your account for any sessions attended the previous week.

You can purchase items from the shop (under the tab “payments”). This currently includes uniform and enrichment clubs but other items will be added soon, such as residential trips.

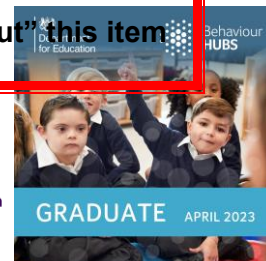
Enrichment clubs – cost a voluntary contribution of £2.00, **please only order and checkout this item once a space at the club has been confirmed by the main office.**



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We will be studying the following subjects this half term.

Maths	We will be looking at place value, ordering and comparing numbers and concentrating on formal methods of addition and subtraction.
English	We are looking at developing vocabulary and sentence structure and creating wonderful sentences. We are looking at non-fiction and fiction texts and we will be writing stories using a good model text to help us structure our writing.
Art/DT	Exploring, using and choosing different media in order to pictures which make a story. Designing and making menus for a specific purpose and using ingredients to produce a finished meal.
Geography/History	Romans – the Roman invasion and what life was like in Britain once the Romans had invaded.
Science	Teeth and the Digestive system – understanding the teeth we have and how to look after them, how we digest our food. Materials – how we can sort materials and what is important about them. How some materials can change state and how some return to that state and how some are not able to return to how they started.
RE	Understanding the religion of Sikhism and how it is worshipped.
PSHE	Understanding rights and responsibilities and how we accept and follow those rights and duties.
French	Understanding how to say 'I can' and matching French verbs. To be able to discuss my name and things about me.
Music	Listening to and understanding Music genre such as ABBA. How the music and lyrics tell and story and the origins of ABBA. Playing musical instruments in time, with rhythm and with variation in speed and volume.
Computing	How to keep safe online. How to use Microsoft Word.

If you need a quick word you can talk to us on the playground after school but if you want a private or longer conversation it is best to leave a message with the office for us to call back.
