### School Dinners

If you pay for your child’s school dinners you will need to top up the account labelled “dinners”. Each day we take a register online and the money will show as debited from your account.

### Breakfast Club and Care Club

You will continue to book the club with the main office.

If your child is a regular attender at breakfast club or care club you will need to top up the accounts labelled “Breakfast Club” and “Care Club”.

On a Monday afternoon we will debit your account for any sessions attended the previous week.

### Shop

You can purchase items from the shop (under the tab “payments”). This currently includes uniform and enrichment clubs but other items will be added soon, such as residential trips.

Enrichment clubs – cost a voluntary contribution of £2.00, **please only order and “checkout” this item once a space at the club has been confirmed by the main office.**

We will be studying the following subjects this half term.

Maths	Place value and the number system. Understanding the value of each number, rounding numbers, placing them on a number line. Adding numbers up to 5 digits.
English	We are studying ‘Zoo’ by Anthony Browne. We will be writing a narrative and a balanced argument. We will look at grammar throughout and focus on our sentence structure and upskilling our sentences to include ambitious vocabulary and punctuation.
Art	Looking at styles of writing, how writing is designed. We will be producing a typography piece of art.
History	Anglo-Saxons - When the Anglo-Saxons invaded and how life changed in Britain under the Anglo-Saxon rule.
Science	Space -The universe, the solar system and the relationship between our planet and the sun. The importance of the planets within our solar system.
RE	This half-term we are going to be learning about the core beliefs behind the religion of Hinduism.
French	Learning how to ask for common French foods and conversation in a café.
Music	Listening to and understanding Rock Music., the features of the music and how this differs from
Computing	Keeping safe online and how computers are used in everyday life.

Halvergate and Reedham class work closely together and if you need a quick word you can talk to us on the playground after school but if you want a private or longer conversation it is best to leave a message with the office for us to call you back.
