SRB Extension

Hopefully you received the link this week to the consultation on extending our autism base from 10 pupils to 16 pupils. This is an exciting opportunity for us to be part of Norfolk County Council's 'Local First Inclusion' programme that is expanding SEND provision across Norfolk. If the outcome of the consultation is successful, we will be adding younger children to our SRB with an anticipated staggered start in Autumn 2024. ([Consultation to extend our Autism Base](#))

Please be aware this is a provision we host on behalf of Norfolk County and access to this provision is through a Norfolk SEND panel process. We don't get to decide who attends this provision and all Norfolk schools are entitled to apply for children to attend.
