

PUPIL PREMIUM

WHAT IS PUPIL PREMIUM

Pupil premium is a grant which school can apply for to help improve educational outcomes for eligible pupils.



IS MY CHILD ELIGIBLE?

The following groups are eligible for pupil premium:

- Pupils who are recorded as eligible for free school meals (FSM).
- Children looked after by the local authority.
- Children previously looked after by the local authority.
- Pupils who have a parent in the armed services.



HOW DO I FIND OUT IF MY CHILD IS ELIGIBLE FOR FREE SCHOOL MEALS?

If you are in receipt of certain benefits your child may be entitled to free school meals, saving you up to £470 per year per child.

Visit your academy website to find out more about how to apply in your local area.

Even if your child is in reception, Year 1 or 2 please apply to the school and secure the benefit for Year 3 onwards.



HOW WE USE THE FUNDING?

- Targeted teaching
- Assistant time 1:1
- Pastoral support when required
- Trips/music subsidised
- Prioritised club registry



ARMED SERVICES

The pupil premium service funding can be used for pastoral support and to help with transitions and mobility.
