Parentmail – changes to Breakfast and Care Club

To improve our processes in school and allow for a smoother running of the provision itself, we will be moving to a register based payment system for Breakfast and Care Club.

This means that your account will be debited within 24hrs, rather than the following week.

This change will take effect from 15/04/2024, from this date all parents will see 3 accounts which can be topped-up - Breakfast Club, Care Club 1st hr and Care Club 2nd hr.

Any current credit or debt will automatically be moved over to the new accounts.

All booking procedures/club rules remain the same:-

- Booking opens on a Thursday and closes on a Friday at 4:00pm for the following week.
- Bookings can be taken in person at the main office, over the phone or via email to office@ewoa.co.uk
- We are **not** able to accept late bookings, unless it is deemed exceptional circumstances.
- Pupils must be collected at their allocated time, e.g. if booked in till 4:00pm, must be collected at 4:00pm, if booked in till 5:00pm, must be collected at 5:00pm (unless otherwise agreed by the academy)
- Breakfast Club = £2.00 per child, per day
- Care Club = £2.50 per hour, per child, per day
