Homework will be set on a Friday. We use Learning with Parents. There is a focus on times tables in Year 4 in order to prepare the children for the Year 4 Times Table test. Children should complete TTRS at least 3 times each week. We also expect the children to read at home at least 3 times a week. **There will be prizes for children who achieve this.**

We will be studying the following subjects this half term.

Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Perimeter and area, shape and symmetry, money and money problems, position and direction, 3D shape, patterns and sequences.
English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We are looking at developing vocabulary and sentence structure and creating wonderful sentences. We are looking at non-fiction and fiction texts and we will be writing stories using a good model text to help us structure our writing. We will also be writing explanations and poems.
Art/DT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be drawing 'still life' looking at the work of other artists that used this style of art. In DT we will be making and exploring circuits.
Geography/History	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> We will be studying the Mayan civilisation in History and looking at the United States of America in Geography.
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sound – how sounds are made, the range of sounds and the effect of vibrations. Electricity – exploring circuits and how they work – making own and using this knowledge to create a model in DT that lights up.
RE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understanding the religion of Islam and how it is worshipped.
PSHE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understanding money and how to look after our money, budget and save.
French	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Learning the French words for clothes and then learn about Ancient Britain and how to say key things in French.
Music	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Listening to and understanding Music Playing musical instruments in time, with rhythm and with variation in speed and volume. Discussing how music is made – singing together and in parts.
Computing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Coding and algorithms. Making a turtle move in response to code. Looking at emails and communication.

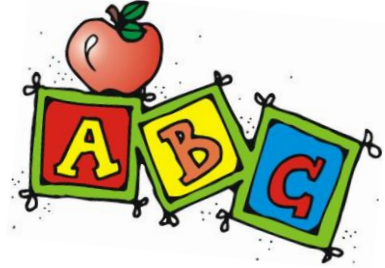
