What has my child achieved on The Scholars Programme?

- Your child has worked closely with a PhD Tutor, who is either studying to gain a PhD or already has one. They have studied a 'super-curricular' course, exploring a topic they may not usually study in the school curriculum in a series of small group, university-style tutorials.
- o Many of these PhD Tutors are lecturers to students at university level, so it has been a unique opportunity for your child to experience university-style teaching.
