## English:

We will be reading the following books: Ruby's Worry, Perfectly Norman, All Aboard the London Bus, Where The Wild Things Are, Katie and the Sunflowers, The Proudest Blue and Rosie's Walk.

## Maths:

We will be learning numbers within 10, addition and subtraction within 10, shape and patterns, numbers to 20 and addition and subtraction within 20.

## Humanities:

Before half term we will be focusing on geography learning about our local area. After half term we will be studying history looking at toys in time.

## Science:

We will be learning about different everyday materials and their properties. We will understand the difference between objects and materials.

## Art and DT:

In art we will be learning drawing techniques, focusing on lines and spirals.  
After half term we will be looking at cooking and nutrition in DT.

## RE:

Pupils will be learning about Christianity and the Creation Story.

## Music:

Pupils will continue to develop their understanding of pulse, pitch and rhythm by exploring a wide range of musical genres.

## PSHE:

Pupils will learn about the differences between EYFS and Year 1. Pupils will also learn about different feelings and how we can show them. We will also talk about how different emotions can change people's behaviour.

## Computing:

This term pupils will be learning about E-Safety and how to log in to the computer using their own log on details.

## PE:

Pupils will be learning how to follow instructions and use the space safely. Children will be studying Health and Fitness and Hockey.

If you have any questions, please speak to a member of the year 1 team. Much of the children's learning will be through Continuous Provision although we will be beginning to introduce the children to some aspects of formal learning gradually in the coming weeks.
