We will be studying the following subjects this term:

<b>Maths</b>	We will be looking at place value within 100; addition and subtraction of 2-digit numbers including word problems; exploring length, graphs and multiplication and division.
<b>English</b>	We will be looking at both fiction and non-fiction texts this term. Our writing will be based on the following books: The Day the Crayons Quit; George and the Dragon; The Great Fire of London; and My Christmas Star. We will be looking at developing vocabulary and sentence structure.
<b>Art/ DT</b>	In art we will be looking at the portraits and profile portraits After half term we will be focusing on cooking and designing and making a healthy pasta salad.
<b>Geography/ History</b>	This term we are learning about the Kings and Queens of England and after half term we will be learning about the Great Fire of London.
<b>Science</b>	We will be learning about the uses of materials including their properties. After half term we will be learning about Animals and Survival.
<b>RE</b>	We will be focusing on Christianity this term and exploring the role the Bible has in their lives. After half term we will be looking at festivals and celebrations.
<b>PSHE</b>	We will be learning about growth mindset which includes how we can be resilient, independent, participate and collaborate. After half term we will be looking at different types of families.
<b>Music</b>	Pupils will be looking at the following Charanga units from the Modal Music curriculum: Pulse, Rhythm and Pitch; and Playing in an Orchestra.
<b>Computing</b>	Up until half term we will be looking at information technology in the world. We will also concentrate on e-safety and keeping safe online.
