| <b>Home Learning</b>        | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Additional home learning tasks will be set when required to ensure progress of all children. Additional home learning tasks are available on the Home Learning Wall in the Year 6 corridor and will be rewarded upon completion.</li> <li>Support with any additional learning is available every break time in class.</li> </ul>   |
| <b>Reading</b>              | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>It is essential that you read regularly. We need to continue to improve our <b>fluency</b> (how many words read) and <b>comprehension</b> (understanding what has been read).</li> <li>We expect children to read for at least <b>15 minutes 5 x a week</b>.</li> <li>Children can quiz on their Accelerated Reading book <b>at home or in school</b> to check their comprehension.</li> <li>We encourage children to read for pleasure, choosing books that they enjoy. We also have a wide range of subject specific reference books children can borrow to enhance subject knowledge.</li> </ul> |
| <b>Additional Resources</b> | <p>As part of the end of Year 6 writing expectations, children should be able to confidently spell all of the Year 5/6 Statutory Spellings. Spelling practice is built into every English lesson and a list of that week's focus spelling is provided. The full list is provided with some recommended spelling practice ideas.</p> <p>Instant times table recall is essential for a range of mathematical challenges and Times Table Rockstars builds upon the compulsory Multiplication Check in Year 4. Further resources to assist with recall of multiplication facts are available on request.</p>                                   |
