Module Overview

Future Stars is made up of 3 modules:

Module 1

- In-school workshop, with activity workbook, introducing university and UEA.

Module 2

- Campus visit to explore UEA, meet current UEA students and take part in subject-specific workshops.

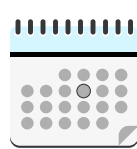
Module 3

Key Information



Each school is invited to sign up 30 Year 5 students, who will take part in all 3 modules.



The 3 modules will all take place across one academic term – either Autumn, Spring or Summer (more details will be given by your Outreach Officer).



All 3 modules are compulsory. We can only deliver Future Stars if all 3 modules are agreed to.



It is also **compulsory** to provide UEA with student data for all students taking part (we do this safely and securely and can talk you through the process).
